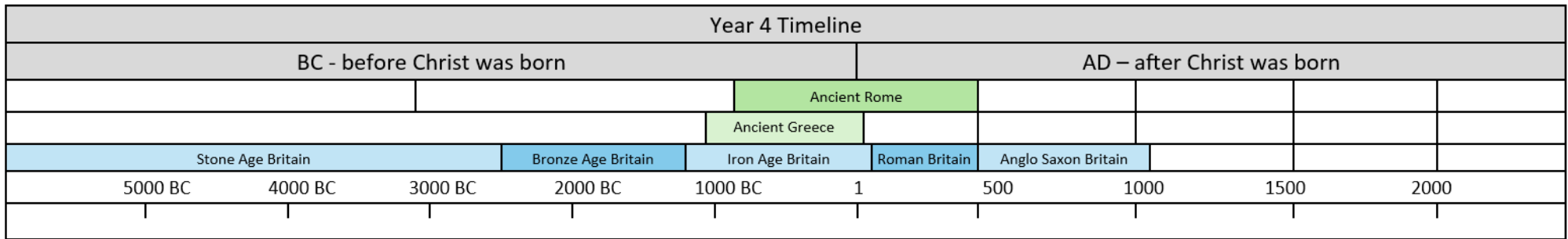
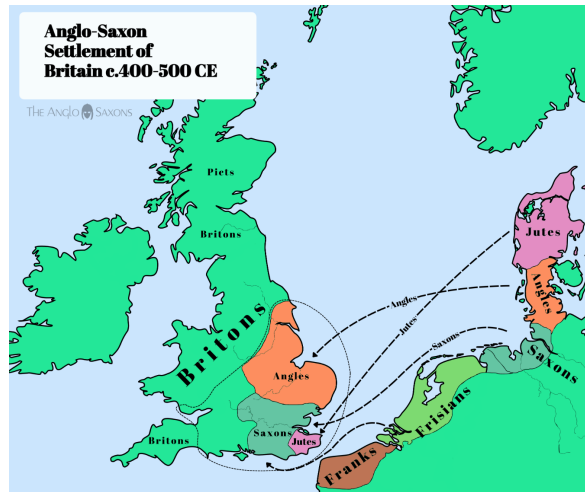


Who were the Anglo Saxons—Where did they come from and where did they go?

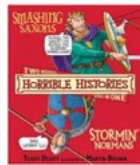
An original and replica Anglo-Saxon comb
