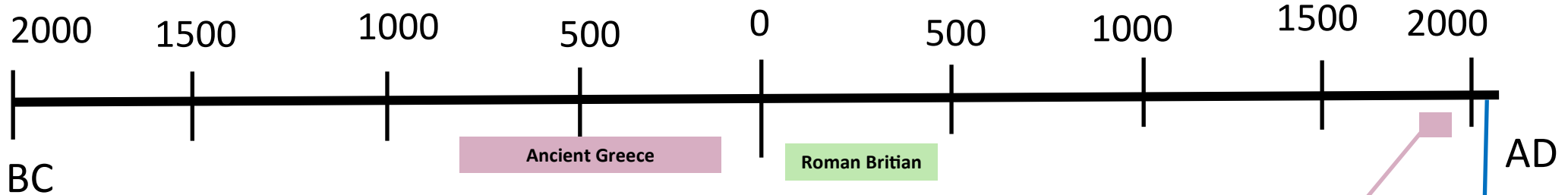


# What did the Romans do for us?
