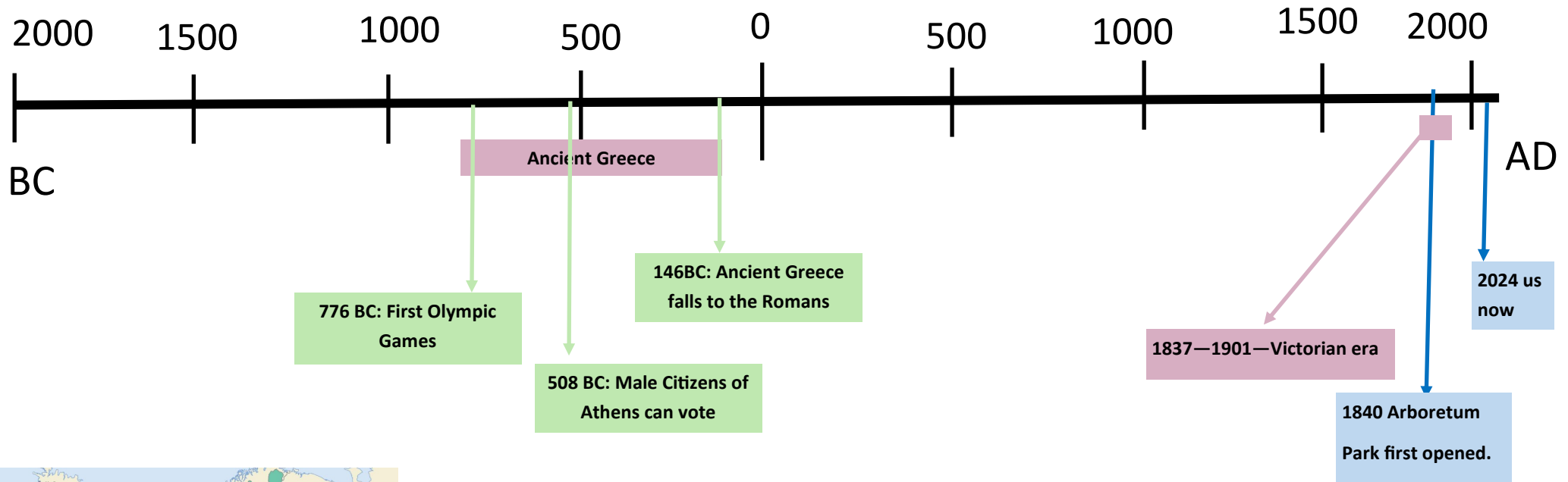


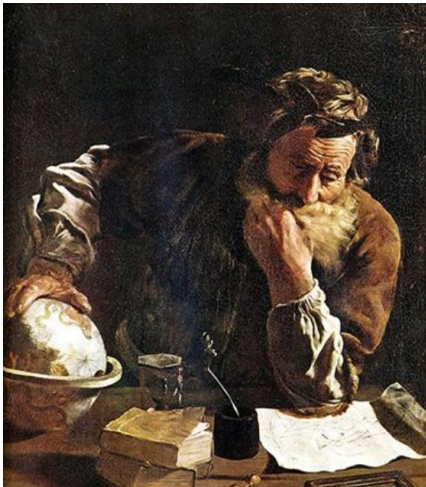

The Ancient Greeks held the first Olympic Games

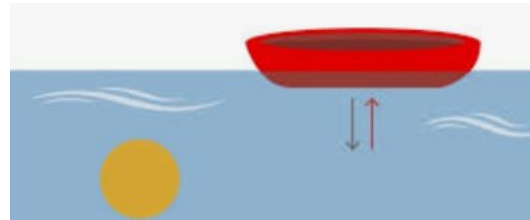
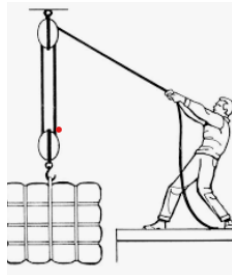
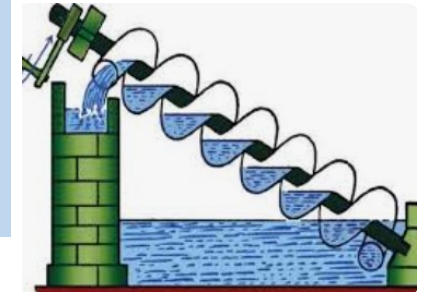


History



Archimedes

Archimedes was born in 287 B.C. and died in 212 B.C. He was an inventor, a Greek scientist, a mathematician and an astronomer. He invented the Archimedes Screw, the laws of floating (buoyancy) and levers and pulleys
